

Off-Campus Access to Full-Text



Most of the library's electronic resources - databases, journals, books and reprints are only accessible to Tel-Aviv University community and are not accessible to the general public. To access these resources off campus please configure the proxy settings in your computer.

This is a one-time step that will serve you throughout your studies.

Configuring the Proxy Settings for Windows 8 and Windows 10

- Go to SEARCH WINDOWS  Search Windows and look for "PROXY".
- Choose the CHANGE PROXY SETTINGS.
- Turn USE SETUP SCRIPT on.
- In the Script address type: `http://www.tau.ac.il/remote.pac`
- Save the new settings.

- Look for the "Settings" sign on the side of the address bar of your web browser and click on it.
- Look for BLOCK OR ALLOW POP-UPS, and choose ALLOW POP-UPS.
- Make sure that "TURN ON POP-UP BLOCKER" is not selected.

After configuring PROXY settings in your computer, whenever you connect to the library's resources, an identification screen will automatically appear. Log-in with your university Username and Password.
